2.1 Eligibility and Technical Requirements:


- PhilGEPS Certificate – Platinum Membership;
- Statement of all on going government and private contracts within the period of two (2) years from submission of bids, including contracts awarded but not yet started if any, whether similar or not similar in nature and complexity to the contract to be bid. This statement shall be supported with any of the ff:
 - Notice of Award and/or Contract, or, Notice to proceed issued by the owner or the agency;

- c. Statement of all completed government and private contracts which are similar in nature within the period of five (5) years. Only the bidder's single largest completed contract that is similar in nature to this project shall be supported with the complete documentary evidence enumerated below
- Notice of Award
 - Certificate of Completion and/or Sales Invoice, and
 - Certificate of Acceptance and/or Official Receipt
- d. Audited Financial Statements, showing, among others, the prospective bidder's total and current assets and liabilities stamped "received" by the BIR or its duly accredited and authorized institution for the calendar year 2017 and 2018;
- e. Computation of Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC);
- f. **Bid Securing Declaration, or any form of Bid Security**, in an amount not less than the required percentage of Approved Budget of the Contract and in the prescribed form and validity period;
- g. **Technical specifications, should include the ff:**
- production/delivery schedule
 - manpower requirements
 - warranty certificate
 - brochures
 - certificate of training of service engineers
 - authorization from manufacturer
 - country of origin
 - Certificate of availability of parts within five (5) years
 - Certificate of Exclusive Distributorship, if applicable
 - after sales service/parts;
- h. Omnibus Sworn Statement by the prospective bidder or its duly authorized representative in the form prescribed by the GPPB.

2.2 Financial Proposal

- a. Duly signed bid form
 - b. Duly Signed Bid Prices in the Bill of Quantities for Procurement of Goods, or Scope of Work for Procurement of Services (Quotation)
 - c. Detailed Breakdown of the Contract Cost (Main Equipment, Accessories, Training, Installation Cost, etc.)
 - d. Recurring and maintenance cost, if applicable
