



INVITATION TO BID

Renovation of Microflow Laboratory

1. The **INDUSTRIAL TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT INSTITUTE**, through the project: **“Facility for Optimized Calibration of Infusion Systems (FOCUS)”** intends to apply the amount of **One Million Three Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand Pesos (P 1,326,000.00)** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the **“Renovation of Microflow Laboratory”**. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
2. The **INDUSTRIAL TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT INSTITUTE (ITDI)** now invites bids for the **“Renovation of Microflow Laboratory”**. Location is at ITDI-DOST Compound Gen. Santos Bicutan, Taguig. Completion of work is required in **Seventy-Five (75) calendar days** upon issuance of Notice to Proceed.
3. Bidders should have completed, within five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders.
4. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary pass/fail criterion as specified in the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”.
5. Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorship, partnerships, or organizations with at least seventy five percent (75%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines.
6. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders from **November 18, 2024 until December 9, 2024** at the ITDI BAC Office, Second Floor Metrology Bldg. upon payment of the applicable fee for Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of **Five Thousand Pesos (P 5,000.00)**.


It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS), provided that Bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.
7. The ITDI-BAC will hold a **Pre-Bid Conference on November 25, 2024, 9:00 AM** at the **Metrology Conference Room, ITDI Metrology Building, DOST Compound Bicutan Taguig City**.
8. Bids must be delivered on **December 9, 2024 between 8:30 A.M. to 9:00 A.M.** at the **Metrology Conference Room, ITDI Metrology Building, DOST Compound Bicutan Taguig City**. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause 18.
9. Bid opening shall be on **December 9, 2024, and will start at 9:01 A.M.** at the **Metrology Conference Room, ITDI Metrology Building, DOST Compound Bicutan Taguig City**. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidder’s representatives who choose to attend. Bids submitted after 9:00 A.M. on December 9, 2024 shall not be accepted.





10. The **INDUSTRIAL TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT INSTITUTE (ITDI)** reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
11. The Bidders shall submit **three (3) copies** of their duly accomplished eligibility requirements, Technical and Financial Proposal into **one (1) sealed envelope**.
12. The participating bidders/contractors should have completed similar project of at least 50% of the ABC, and have the key personnel and equipment, (listed in the eligibility forms) available for the prosecution of the contract. The BAC will use non-discretionary pass and fail criteria in the eligibility. Check/Screening as well as the examination of the bids. The BAC will conduct post qualification of the lowest calculated bid.
13. The ITDI reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, and not to award the contract if 1.) there is a prima facie evidence of collusion between appropriate public officers or employee, or between the BAC and any of the bidders themselves, or between the bidders and a third party, including any act which restricts, suppresses, or nullifies or tends to restrict, suppress or nullify competition; 2.) the BAC is found to have failed in the prescribed bidding procedures; or 3) for any justifiable and reasonable ground where the award of the contract will not redound to the benefit of the government as defined in the IRR.
