De Yro - ICNMS 2019 Best Presenter



Dr. Persia Ada N. de Yro of the Materials Science Division bagged the Best Presenter award during the 7th International Conference on Nano and Materials Science (ICNMS 2019) held in San Francisco, California, USA last January 4-7, 2019.

Dr. De Yro received the award for her confident, energetic, clear, and content-rich presentation on the study "Hydrothermal Synthesis of Carbon Quantum Dots from Biowaste for Bio-imaging." She shares authorship of the study with Gerald Mari O.

Quaichon, Roland Andrew T. Cruz, Carlo S. Emolaga, Mar Christian O. Que, and MSD Chief Dr. Blessie A. Basilia.

She also presented another study entitled “Thermolytic Growth of Zinc Sulfide Quantum Dots in Ethylene-Vinyl Acetate Matrix Utilizing Zinc Pyrrolidinedithiocarbamate,” which she coauthored with Que and Dr. Basilia.

The two papers will be published in the conference proceedings of the American Institute of Physics (AIP). AIP’s conference proceedings are currently indexed in leading databases such as The Conference Proceedings Citation Index (CPCI), Scopus (Elsevier), and Inspec. Conference proceedings are highly valued by researchers world-wide because they dig deeper into conferences and meetings to reveal emerging trends and new ideas before they appear in journals. Proceedings allow users to track influence of papers, authors, and conference series.

ICNMS 2019 is organized by the South Asia Institute of Science and Engineering (SAISE). It provides opportunities for delegates to exchange new ideas and application experiences, establish business or research relations, and find global partners for future collaboration. Meanwhile, SAISE is a US-registered association dedicated to promotion of international communication and cooperation among researchers and practitioners in the science and engineering areas.
