

DOST-ITDI invites fabricators for Vinegar Acetator Kit

The Industrial Technology Development Institute (DOST-ITDI) is inviting local developers to become licensed fabricators of the ITDI-developed vinegar acetator kit.

The move intends to increase the country's self-sufficiency of local fabricators thereby decreasing dependence on imported equipment.

The acetator kit can accelerate the traditional fermentation process of producing vinegar within one day instead of the conventional 30 to 90 days.

Easy to operate, production can start with a minimal initial volume of 200 liters (coconut water) and requires only a minimum processing area. Vinegar can be drawn out from the acetator at a minimum daily rate of 20 liters or 150 liter per drum. Other juices from tropical fruits like pineapple can also be used.

Interested parties may submit the following requirements to a DOST Regional Office near you for assessment:

1. Letter of Intent;
2. Company Profile;
3. Business Plan;
4. Registration of Business;
5. Audited Financial Statement; and
6. List of at least five clients with contact details.
