GFMIC. Inc. has as its members, government financial management professionals that are using eNGAS (electronic New Government Accounting System) and eBudget system as well as other financial management information systems.

The eNGAS was developed in 2006 by the Commission on Audit (COA). It is a software tool designed to simplify government accounting processes and ensure conformity with international accounting standards. The eBudget System, on the other hand, records and keeps track of budget-related transactions in order to facilitate monitoring of financial status and balances.
