EBD Researchers Receive the First Filemon D. Tanchoco Scientific Discoverer Award



Researchers from the Environment and Biotechnology Division (EBD) of the Department of Science and Technology-Industrial Technology Development Institute (DOST-ITDI) were honored with the first-ever Filemon D. Tanchoco Scientific Discoverer Award. The recognition was presented on December 4, 2024, at the Manila Central University (MCU) for their work on the SAFEWATRS Mobile Water Disinfection System.

Originally developed for disaster response, the SAFEWATRS Mobile Water Disinfection System has become a transformative solution for communities lacking access to potable water. The innovative, mobile, and energy-independent technology has been deployed in 18 remote and underserved areas across the Philippines, ensuring access to clean drinking water in even the most challenging circumstances.

The SAFEWATRS team's achievement exemplifies this vision, embodying the power of science to drive meaningful change.

Earlier this year, SAFEWATRS also received a Silver Medal in the 49th International Exhibition of Inventions Geneva (IEIG).
