DOST-ITDI kicked off it's 18-Day Campaign to End Violence Against Women (VAW) on 23 November 2021 by posting Safe Space Banners on ITDI buildings and official service vehicles.

The kick-off campaign started by hanging up the 18-day campaign to end VAW streamers to Metrology and STD building, followed by the posting of safe spaces banners on all official service vehicles.
