In a captivating display of gender and development (GAD), the ITDI GAD Culminating Activity set the stage at the Century Park Hotel Manila on November 29, 2023. Themed "Pagkakapantay-pantay sa Agham, Sining, at Komunidad," this event was more than a culmination — it was a celebration of accomplishments, recognition, and commitment to GAD objectives.

The anticipated event kicked off with a 'star-studded' red-carpet entrance, as delegates from the ITDI community, guests from the Department of Budget and Management (DBM), and distinguished visitors graced the event. Dr. Zorayda V. Ang, the ITDI's Deputy Director-ATS and overall chairperson of this year's organizing committee, welcomed the attendees with warmth, setting the tone for an event with inspiration and celebration. As distinguished speakers, the messages of DOST Secretary Dr. Renato U. Solidum Jr. and Atty. Kristine E. Yuzon-Chaves, Executive Director of the Philippine Commission on Women (PCW), added their perspectives on the theme, emphasizing the importance of equality in the workplace, leaving the audience motivated and enlightened.

Dr. Annabelle V. Briones, ITDI Director, presented a comprehensive year-end report highlighting the Institute's accomplishments. The event continued to spotlight excellence, further acknowledging outstanding contributions through the presentation of GAD Awards by Dr. Ang. Notably, ITDI's achievements in GAD serve as proof that the Institute actively promotes, implements, and recognizes gender and development in the workplace. ITDI is the pioneering DOST-attached agency that has officially registered GAD logo to the Intellectual Property Office of the Philippines (IPOPHL), contributing to the Institute's campaign to end Violence Against Women (VAW). Another significant milestone for ITDI in GAD was the recognition of GAD-responsive GAA Projects for the first time. The awarded projects that were implemented for the year 2022-2023 were "Development of Three New RTE Disaster Relief Foods for Vulnerable Groups (Elderly and Children)" of the PTD and "Development of New Shelf-Stable Food Products from Fruits, Grains, and Vegetables" of the Food Processing Division (FPD). These achievements emphasized ITDI's commitment to reinforcing genderresponsive activities and recognizing the profound importance of gender and development in project implementation.
